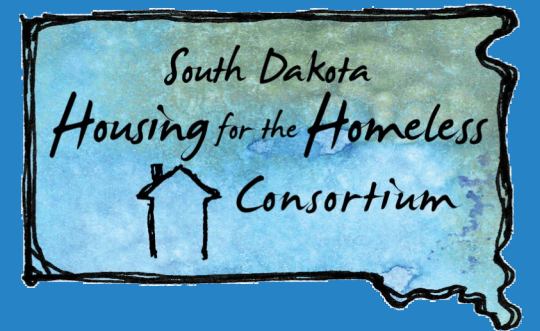

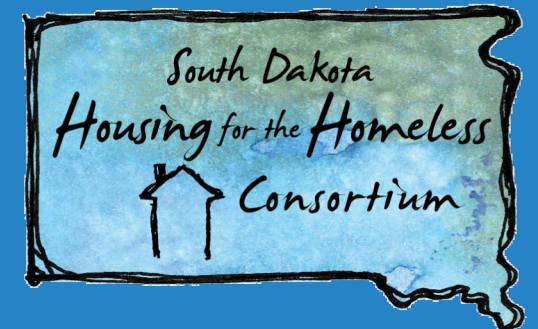

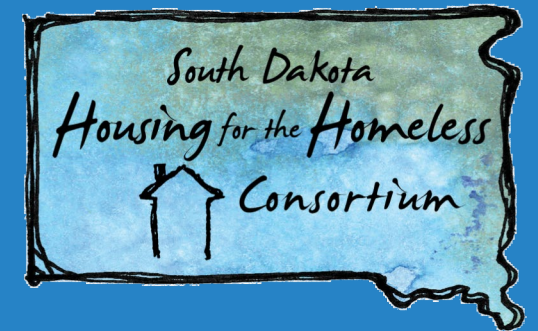
SDHHC Membership

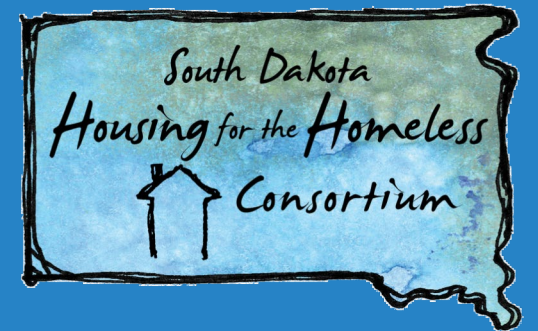

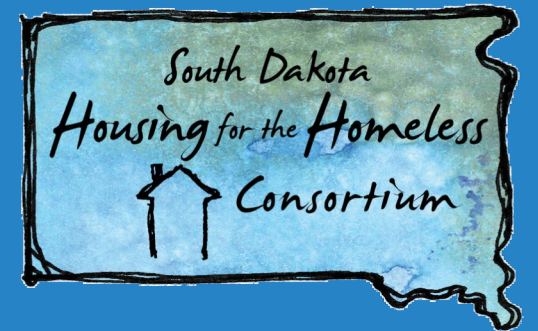

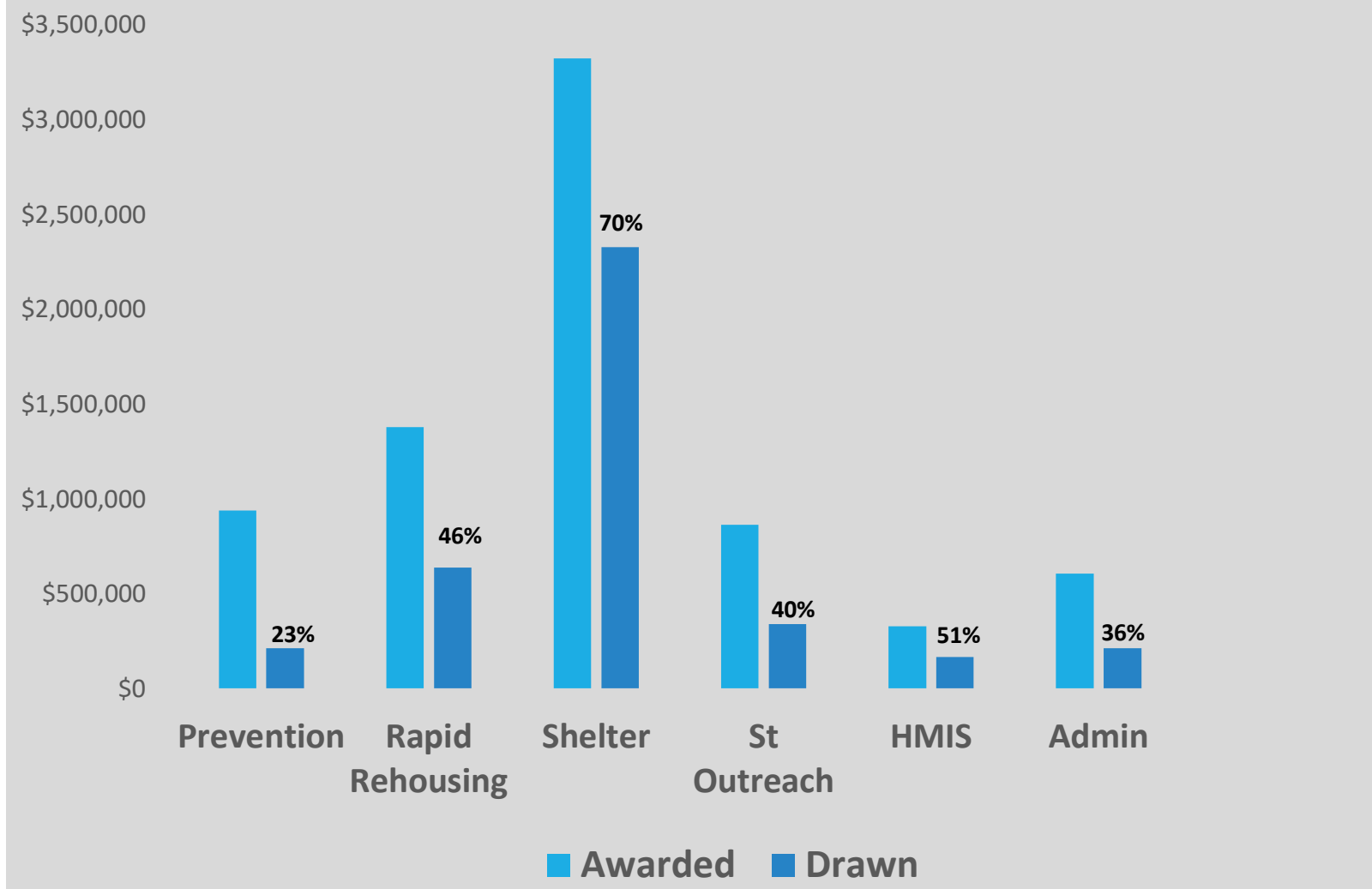

Expenditure Deadlines:

- 20% by 9/30/21 – Met this deadline
- 50% by 6/16/22 – Updated deadline
- 100% by 9/30/23 – Updated deadline!

Total Allocation = \$7,754,851

Drawn To-Date = \$3,920,634.36 (thru 6/8/22)

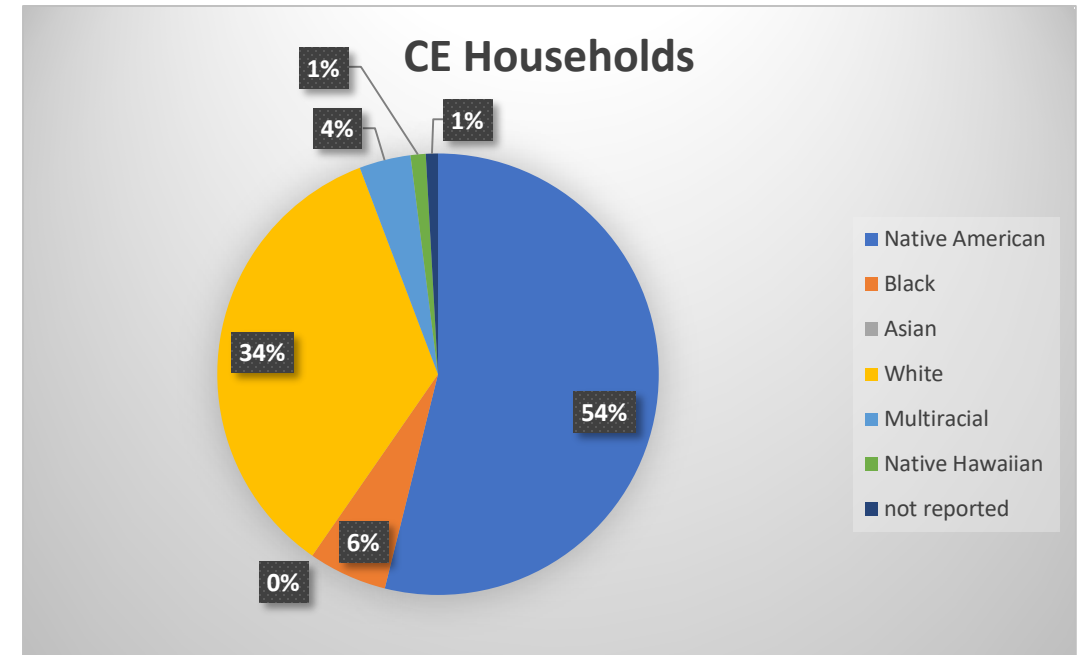
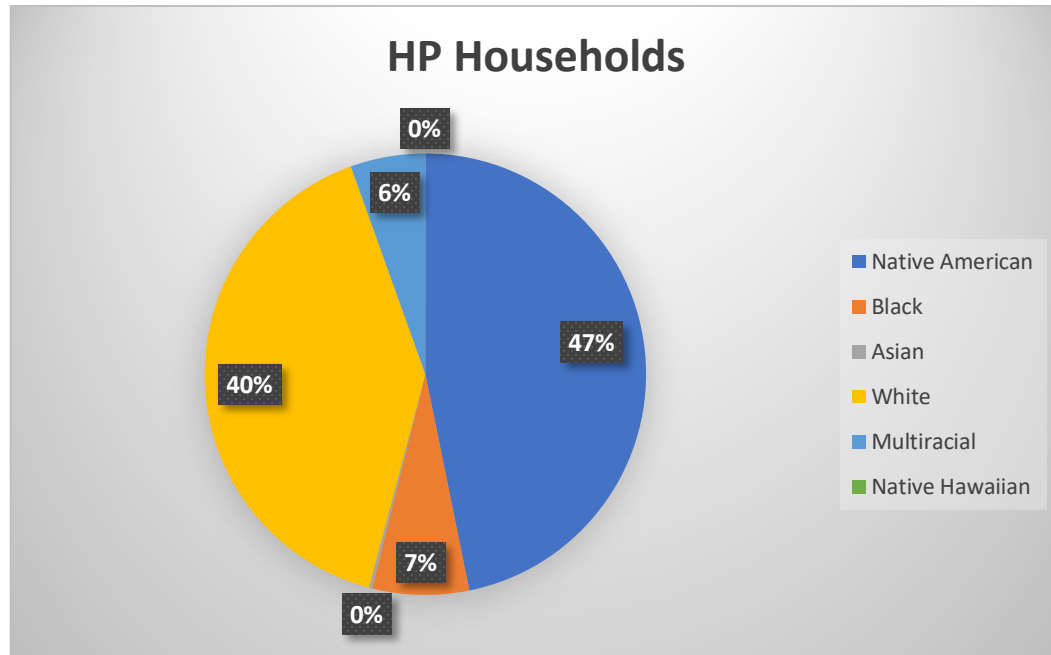
- 239 enrollments in Homeless Prevention

- White households comprise 40% of HP enrollments and 34% of CE.

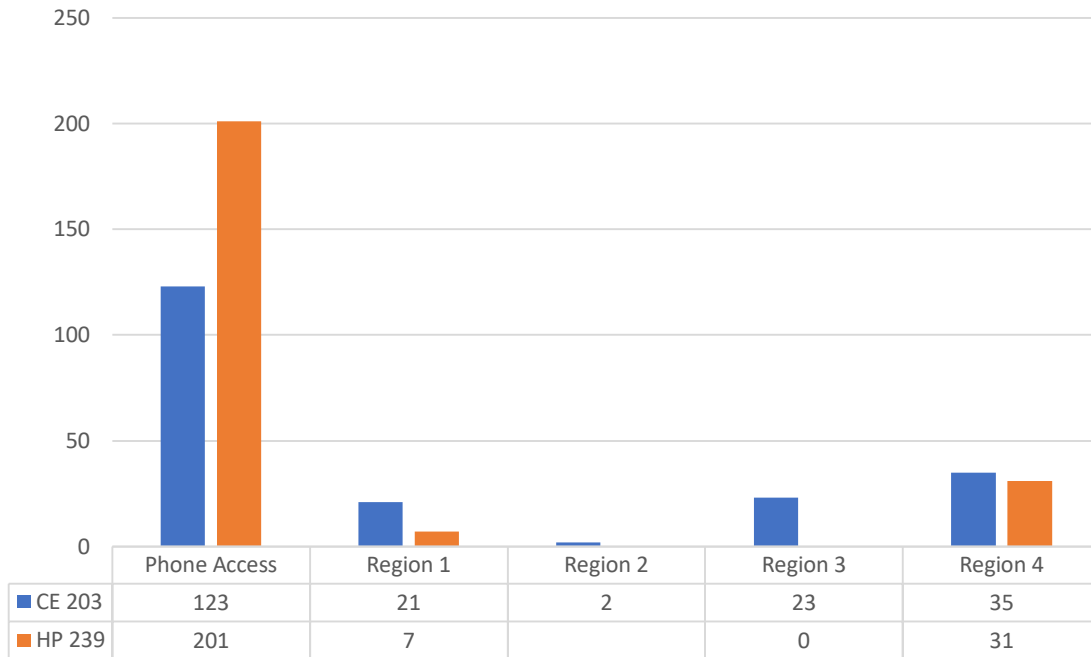

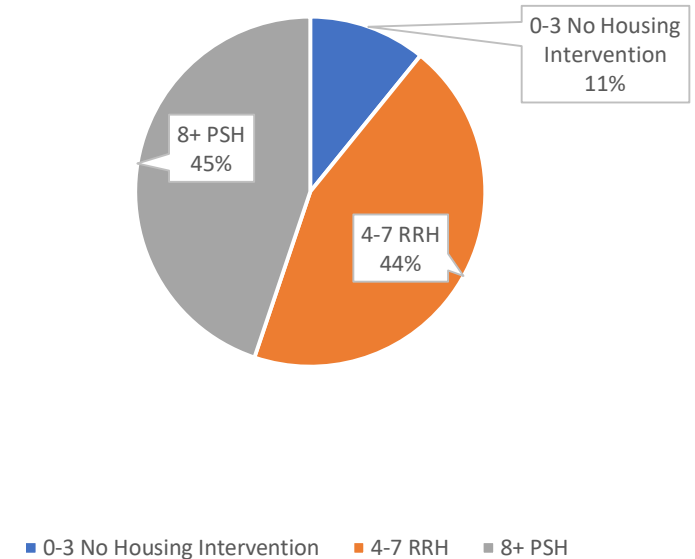

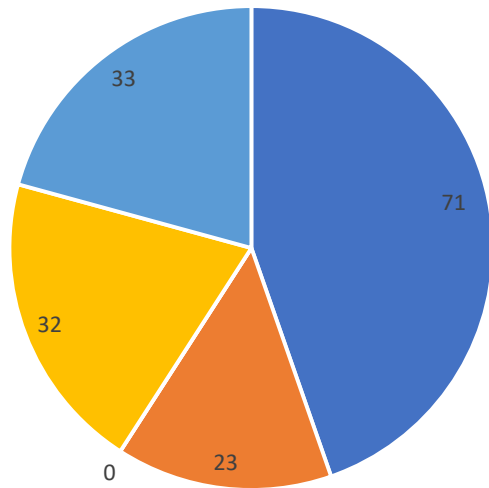

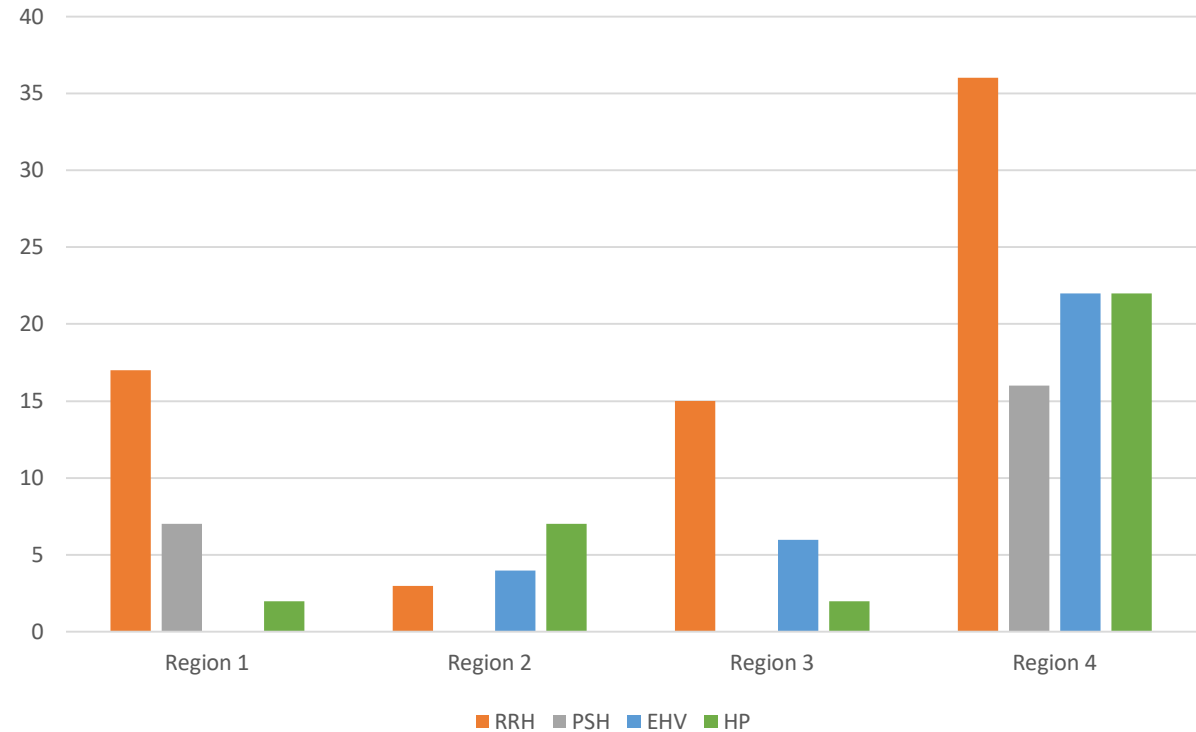

3.1.22-5.31.22

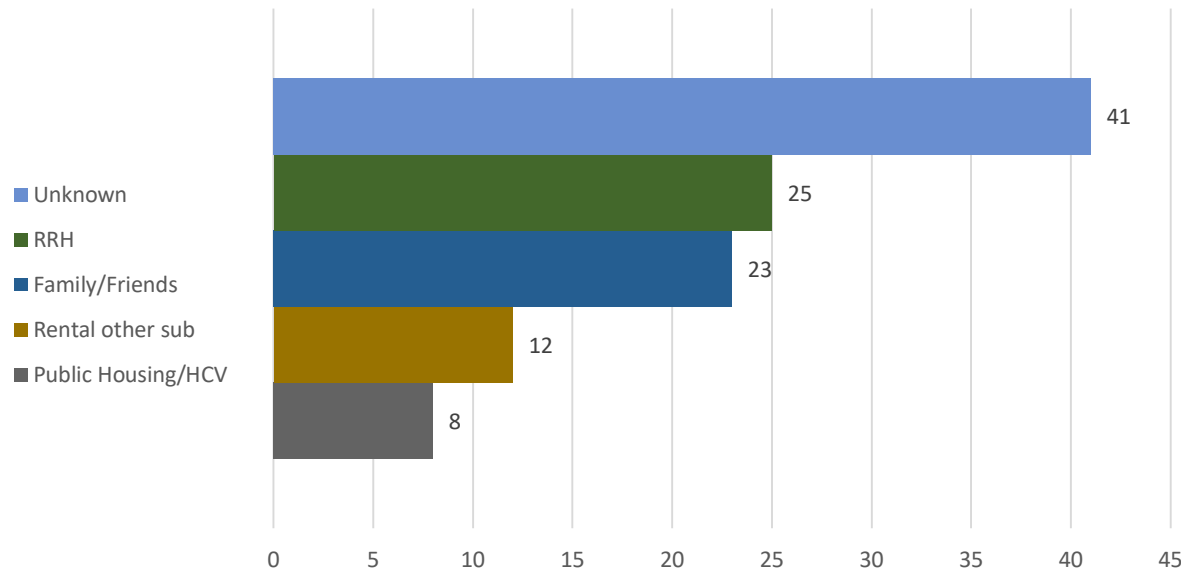

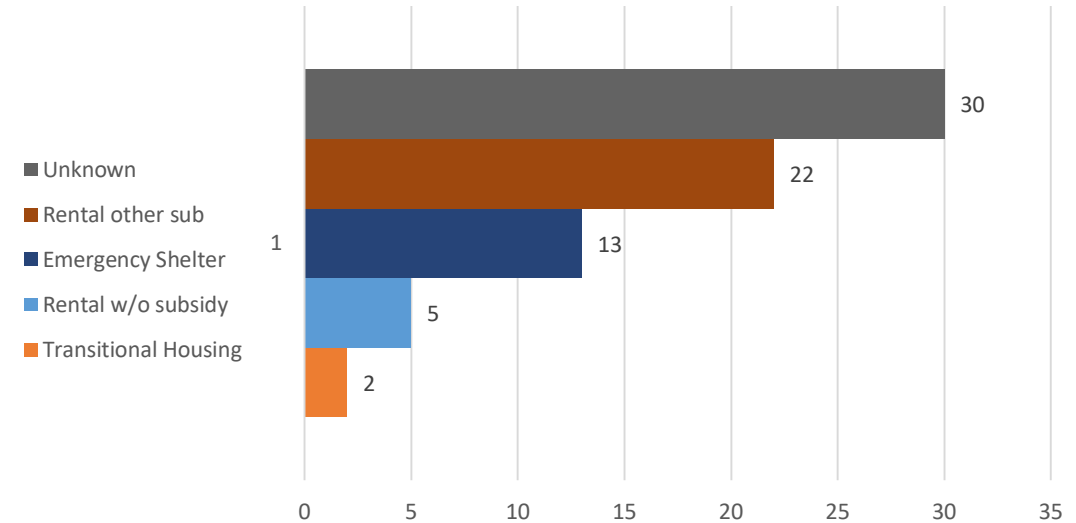

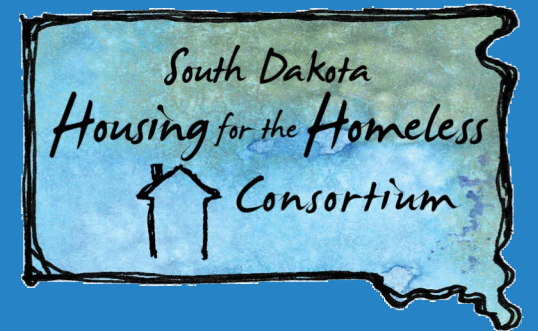
The South Dakota Housing for the Homeless Consortium formed in 2000
